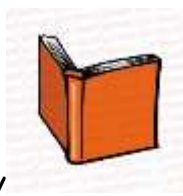

Outdoor Clothing

Please can you make sure that the children come dressed for the day's weather, we go outdoors every day and in all-weather conditions, so please can they have a winter coat, hat and gloves and bring in their own wellies.

Parent meetings

Children's attendance

It is very important that your child comes to nursery on time and comes on the days agreed to help your child learn. If your child has the free funded hours your child must come to nursery unless they are really poorly, if they have a cold or a runny nose they can still come to nursery. If they have been vomiting (being sick) or have diarrhoea they must stay at home for 48 hours.

If your child is not coming to nursery or are going to be late, you must ring 769591 and tell the staff.
