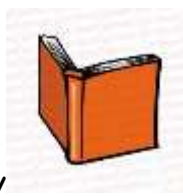

Dates for your Diary

We will be having a Parent/Carer (it includes aunties, uncles and grandparents!!) STAY and PLAY sessions

Outdoor learning

Please can you make sure that the children come dressed for the day's weather, we go outdoors every day and in all-weather conditions, so please can they have a hat and bottle of sun cream labelled with their name to be left at nursery as the sun is getting strong and it is important that ALL children are protected from the sun rays and we WILL be outside every day.

We use the outdoor areas every day as a part of the children's learning and it is important that all children are dressed suitably for the weather.

Parent meetings

Baby room, Toddler room and Pre-school will be holding parent meetings during the summer term, where you can talk about your child with their keyworker and look at your child's personal development file. Please book your appointment time with the room staff it is very important that you attend. Each room will send out letters to inform you of dates.



Children's attendance

It is very important that your child comes to nursery on time and comes on the days agreed to help your child learn. If your child has the free funded hours your child must come to nursery unless they are really poorly, if they have a cold or a runny nose they can still come to nursery. If they have been vomiting (being sick) or have diarrhoea they must stay at home for 48 hours.

It is very important this summer term especially if your child may be going to school in September that you bring your child on time and collect on time to get them ready for school.

If your child is not coming to nursery or are going to be late, you must ring 769591 and tell the staff.
